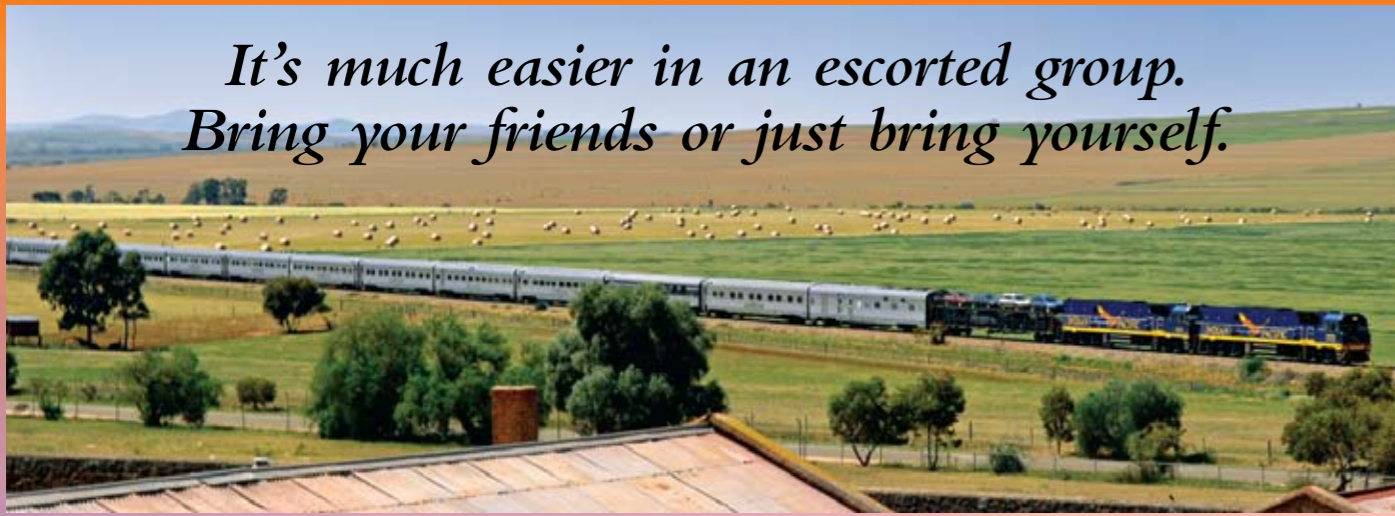

## TOUR INFORMATION AND SPECIAL TERMS

### DEPOSIT AND PAYMENTS

A non-refundable deposit of \$350 per person is required together with a signed booking form within seven days of making a reservation to secure your booking. Final payment of the balance is required 95 days prior to tour departure.

### CANCELLATION CHARGES

Cancellation charges per person are:

95 days or more – loss of deposit

94 – 30 days – 50% of total tour cost

29 days or less prior to departure – 100% of tour cost

Travel insurance for cancellation protection is strongly recommended.

### TOUR ESCORT

A tour escort will be provided from Perth subject to a minimum of 20 passengers travelling.

### HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

We require a health certificate from all tour members aged 70 years or older, and from any passenger travelling with a known condition, indicating that he/she is fit to travel on the tour. There are no vaccinations required to visit Java however we recommend you seek up to date professional advice before travelling.

### IMPORTANT TRAIN INFORMATION

- Twin Sleeper Cabins have a comfortable 3 seater lounge for relaxing during the day and this converts to an upper and lower sleeping berth at night. Ensuite facilities include toilet, wash basin & shower.

- Roomettes/Single Cabins feature one fold out single bed and a hand basin. The showers and toilets are located at the end of the carriage.

- Guests travelling on single supplement will be allocated a roomette on the train. Sole use of a twin cabin is available at extra cost.

### ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

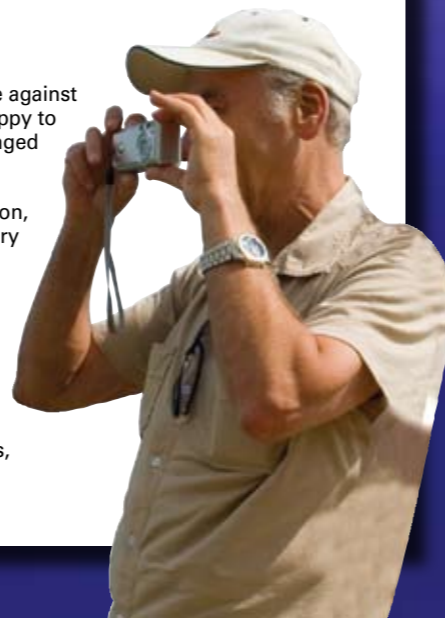
**BOOKING FORM** – Must be completed and signed by all passengers travelling.

### DAY 1 WEDNESDAY 26 JANUARY PERTH - KALGOORLIE

Your Tour Escort, Kevin Pearce will be on hand this morning at the East Perth Rail Terminal to assist with check in. After the *Indian Pacific* has departed Perth it's time to settle in to our Gold Service Sleeper Cabin to relax and enjoy the passing scenery. ### DAY 2 THURSDAY 27 JANUARY KALGOORLIE - NULLARBOR PLAIN

### DAY 3 FRIDAY 28 JANUARY ARRIVE ADELAIDE

Early this morning we arrive at Adelaide's Parklands Rail Terminal. We are then transferred to our luxury hotel for breakfast before embarking on a city sightseeing tour. Visit Colonel Lights Lookout for fabulous views over the city, then to North Adelaide, St Peters Cathedral, and the charming suburb of Hyde Park. We visit the Haigh's Chocolate Factory before taking a trip to Glenelg on the popular Glenelg Tram. After leaving the city streets the tram travels over a former railway line. There is time to purchase morning tea at this popular



beachside suburb before arriving back at our hotel for check in. The remainder of the afternoon is free to further explore Adelaide, or relax in our first class hotel before dinner.
